






Imagine you are a 65 year old peace activist. You have marched in protests against wars and you believe that war is never an answer to any problem. Think about the class question from this point of view.


Imagine you are a member of the parliament. Your jobs include making tax laws, monitoring the military, and creating government policies. Politics is your life. Think about the class question from this point of view.


